ART AND CRAFT SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Art Show welcomes entries from artists residing in, or owning property in Delaware County.

ADVANCE entry forms must be received, by July 31, 2010. Mail advance entries and fees to:

Exhibits that are not entered in advance will be accepted, No Entries accepted after 3 pm on Saturday August 14 with NO EXCEPTIONS.

Entry blanks may be found in this book and online at www.delawarecountyfair.org. Do not include entries for other departments on the art show entry blank.

All artwork must be brought to the fairgrounds Saturday, August 14, from 10 AM - 3 PM. Entries can be picked up between 8 PM and 10 PM Saturday, August 21. **Absolutely no work will leave the building before 8 PM Saturday, August 21.** This is a State Fair rule. Any individual that removes artwork before this time forfeits any prize money they may have been awarded as well as forfeits the right to enter in future Art Shows at the Delaware County Fair. For your convenience, artwork may also be picked up on Sunday morning, August 22, between the hours of 9 AM and 12 Noon. The Art Committee will not be responsible for items left in the building after Sunday, August 22 at 12 Noon.

Because this is a family oriented Art Show, this Committee shall reserve the right to reject or refuse, and to order the removal of any exhibit which, in the opinion of its members, is not eligible or worthy of showing, or has not met the entry requirements. Anyone willfully entering in the wrong category will forfeit their prizes. This Committee also reserves the right to reclassify any exhibit. Taxidermy will no longer be accepted in the Art Show.

All pictures must be properly matted and framed in the adult division. Please be sure all paint is dry. All oils and acrylics must be framed, unless galley wrap canvas is used. All photographs must be framed. Artwork should

be properly wired and secured with wire hanging apparatus on the back. Saw tooth hangers on the back of pictures will be unacceptable for hanging. Please use picture wire only. Work must be sturdy. NO TAPE should be used to support wires on back of work or entries will be refused.

PLEASE NOTE: BECAUSE OF THE HEAT IN THE BUILDING, TAPE WILL NOT ALWAYS HOLD. We are not responsible for any work that falls apart. Owner's name, address, and phone number must be on the back of all work.

There are three divisions (SECTIONS):

PROFESSIONAL - defined as persons who offer their work for sale or who instruct. Professional artists may display their business cards with their work after judging. Exhibits may be marked for sale, but arrangements must be made privately.

AMATEUR - open to all entrants over 18.

JUNIOR - all entrants grades K-12 will compete in the Junior Division, unless you qualify as a Professional. The Junior Division will be subdivided according to grades just completed:

Elementary:	Grades K, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5-6.
Junior High:	Grades 7 - 9.
High School:	Grades 10 - 12.

Three entries per category may be submitted. **The photography division will accept three entries except in the Amateur color and Junior division, which will accept only two entries. This is due to a lack of space.**

First, Second and Third Place Ribbons will be available in all classes, but prizes will only be awarded when deserving, whether there be competition in the category or not.

Judging will take place on Sunday, August 15. Professionals, who are not members of the art committee, will judge all entries in their field and their decisions will be final. The

criteria for the judging in all adult and grades 7-12 entries (except photography) are:

- Originality of subject
- Creative use of medium
- Composition
- Effective use of medium
- Overall eye appeal of exhibit

Junior entries through Grade 6 will be judged on:

- Originality
- Composition
- Overall eye appeal

All photography exhibits will be judged using the following criteria:

- Composition
- Focus
- Exposure
- Originality of subject
- Overall eye appeal of exhibit

Two items will be selected from our ribbon winners to be displayed as our "Best of Show". One winner will be chosen from the Adult category, age 18 and older, and one from the Junior category, Grades K-12. These two exhibitors will each receive a \$55.00 prize.

Articles are not to be handled by any person (other than judges) under any circumstances.

No article shall be exhibited for judging if it has previously been exhibited at the Delaware County Fair. Due to our currently limited space, we ask your cooperation in keeping your exhibits within a reasonable size range. If space is at a premium, some larger works may be judged but not displayed.

No kits, liquid embroidery, macrame, needlework, fabric crafts or silk flowers will be accepted in the art show (see Dept. H).

The Art Show Committee shall take every precaution for the safekeeping of all exhibits, but assume no responsibility in case of loss or damage and upon this condition only are entries received.

2011 FAIR BOOK COVER CONTEST

2011 Theme -- 125th Annual Delaware County Fair

The Delaware County Fair Art Committee will accept entries from January 10, 2011 through February 25, 2011. This contest is open to all youths attending school in Delaware County.

DIVISIONS: Grades K, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5-6, 7-9, 10-12.

PRIZES: First, Second, Third and Honorable Mention in each division. Three grand prizes will be chosen from First prize winners. They will appear on the front and back covers and on the poster. The dollar amounts of the prizes

are:

Prizes will only be awarded when deserving, whether there be competition in the category or not.

Please submit on white paper up to 9" x 12", using your paper vertically. "Remember that this is an agriculture fair," and the winning poster will be the cover of the fair book. The lettering is very important so please make sure it is clear and that all information is included and spelled correctly. No computerized artwork will be accepted. Please note, Black and white drawings reprint better than color.

Front: The following must be incorporated in the design "125th Annual Delaware County Fair, Walton, NY August 15-20, 2011."

Back: Please list name, complete address for mailing purposes, phone number and age of student. Also please put the name of the school and the grade the student is in.

Entries that have not complied with these rules will be disqualified.

All entries will become the property of the art show. Remember, you may enter more than one cover.
