



Dear Delaware County Fair Friend

On November 29th, 2009, The Delaware County Fair suffered a big loss when arsonists set the 4-H horse barn on fire. It was a total loss along with \$18,000 worth of electrical service and another \$10,000 worth of horse show equipment that was stored in the barn.

The horse barn was built in 1976 and was primarily used for 4-H horse shows during the summer and for the Delaware County Fair. The total estimated loss of the barn, equipment and electrical service is \$178,000. Estimated cost of replacing everything is in the \$200,000 range. The Delaware County Fair had \$32,000 worth of insurance on the barn.

The Delaware County Fair is launching a huge fundraising drive to help cover the cost of a new barn for the fair and the 4-H kids. Without help, we would have to use temporary housing (tents) until we have enough money to build a new barn.
